

## Keeping the main thing the main truth! W/C 20th Sept 2020

There was no-one greater than Paul when it came to living by the law, and no one less likely to embrace the gospel of grace. A rigid Pharisee, a fanatical persecutor of the church, he was headed for a high position amongst the religious elite. Then he met Jesus, he encountered the truth, and his life would be headed in a totally different direction.

Paul's calling was to share the gospel, primarily, with the Gentiles, a task unthinkable for any everyday Jew. Yet that was his calling, appointed by God himself.

It seems however, that Paul had a following, not only of sincere believers, but also by a group of troublemakers called 'Judiaisers'. They challenged Paul's ministry and brought into question Paul's insistence that salvation was through grace alone and through faith alone.

The challenges to Paul's ministry grew and eventually things came to a head as Paul went to Jerusalem to meeting with the church leaders there and to put forward his case.
